RSE in year 5

In the Summer Term:

How can you support your child @ home?

- Throughout the year, keep learning the y5/6 spelling words
 these came home last week
- Read with your child @ home they should read ALOUD and record this in their log (both school reader & their choice of book) ASK questions to check for understanding
- Keep checking the Google classroom for homework tasks and additional messages
- Encourage your child to tackle the homework tasks allowing them to explain their work to you
- Telling the time and revision of times tables continually
