End of School Timings – next week

Starting from Monday 11th September we will be implementing new pick-up times across school. This is to ensure we meet the government guidance regarding the length of the school day.

- Reception children will be collected from the side of school, where they are dropped off, at 3:25pm.
- School will finish for all other year groups at 3.30pm

Just a reminder that school is open to children at 8:45am and the register is taken at 9am.

Building updates

- The school site was inspected by a Wirral Council structural engineer and cleared with regards to the RAAC regulations earlier this year. We are not a school that is facing any possible closures relating to the concrete.
- A new climbing frame has been installed in the KS1 playground along new artificial grass. The children have loved using it at playtimes already and my thanks to the Parent's Association for helping to finance this.
- The school is heating system is also being updated. This means that the entrance to the playground is not in use for the next two weeks.
