11+ tests 2014

- Parents must have the outcome of their child's grammar selection tests before 31st October
- Tests take place in September
- School preference application submitted after test results received

•Parents of children who miss a test must still apply by 31st October – if do not reach the standard then highest non-grammar preference becomes the highest preference

CO-ORDINATION

- If you live in Wirral but want a school place in another local authority (LA), you must apply on the Wirral preference form.
- Parents who don't live in Wirral, but want to apply for a Wirral school, must apply on the preference form issued by their home authority. There will be a single offer of a secondary school place. Parents will be informed of their outcome of their applications by their home LA, <u>not</u> by the LA where the
- school is located.

Will secondary schools know what rank I have put them down?

- Secondary schools are not sent the actual preference forms.
- They are sent:

Name, address, date of birth, current school, siblings and baptism information (if relevant)

Schools are <u>not told</u> in what order their school has been put down as a preference by the parent.




- It is quick and easy
- You can apply from home 24 hours a day, 7 days a week (from 1st September)
- >> No risk your application will be lost in the post
- You will receive an email confirming receipt that your application has been submitted and received by the authority
- The system is secure and has a series of security features that will prevent others from seeing your information
- >> You will receive your offer by e-mail on offer day


WHAT HAPPENS TO MY PREFERENCES?

• CHILDREN IN CARE, STATEMENTED CHILDREN, SIBLINGS AND DISTANCE




THE ADMISSION NUMBER IS APPLIED TO DETERMINE WHO IS OFFERED A PLACE




WHAT DOES EQUAL PREFERENCES MEAN?

THIS MEANS THAT WE GIVE EQUAL VALUE TO ALL PREFERENCES WHEN DRAWING UP THE STACKS AND ONLY LATER ON WILL THE ORDER OF <u>YOUR</u> PREFERENCES BE TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT.



IS THE ORDER OF MY PREFERENCES IMPORTANT?

YES IT IS, BECAUSE IF WE CAN OFFER YOUR CHILD A PLACE AT MORE THAN ONE SCHOOL, THEN WE WILL ALLOCATE A PLACE AT THE SCHOOL YOU NAME AS THE HIGHEST PREFERENCE.



National Allocation Day is 1st March 2014

- •On-line applicants will be sent an e-mail from the LA on this day
- Paper applicants will be posted an offer letter from the LA on this day (2rd class post)
- •The offer will be the highest preference that can be allocated
- •Each LA sends an offer to their own residents on behalf of the LA or admission authority that can offer a place
- •Each child will only get one offer of a place
- •Parents can appeal against the allocation
