# SATS

- As of 2023, SATS were no longer a legal requirement.
- We will use them informally at the end of the year to help with our teacher assessment.
- We will not report the SATS scores to you, as they are reflected within our end of year judgements.

# Literacy Curriculum

- Weekly GPAS (Grammar, punctuation, and spelling) lesson focussing on aspects of grammar.
- Active read session to develop the children's comprehension of a text
- Writing cycle- planning, writing and editing
- Common Exception Words \*
- Read daily through reading for pleasure time and class reader throughout the week.
- Phonics Sessions throughout the week, will transition into Year 2 spelling rules.
- Discreet handwriting lessons, building cursive handwriting. \*

# Maths Curriculum

- Basic numbers skills are the 4 main operations, addition, subtraction division, multiplication which are used throughout each topic covered.
- Use of practical apparatus
- At home practise doubles, half of numbers to 20, number bonds to 20, recognising numbers to 100, counting in 2s, 5s, 10s.
- Column Method
- After half term begin to learn multiplication (tables)
- Telling the time
