This feedback form was aimed at reception parents as a way of capturing their thoughts on their and their child's experience at St Bridget's.

Questions Asked

Please give feedback on the induction period for your child starting St Bridget's September 2017

I have been very happy with all of the information provided by the teachers, and also the 'open door' policy which really feels genuine.

No problems at all.

I am delighted that my children have settled so well so far. They have come out of school happy and full of smiles every day. All the FS2 staff have been wonderful. The mornings and staying for lunch were a great introduction.

We're thrilled with the start my child has made at St Bridget's. Miss Daltrey and Mrs Warburton have been very welcoming, with him keen to role-play his day at school when back at home. He's also loved taking very random pictures on the iPad! The induction has been great to introduce him to the concept of school, particularly with the phased approach so the teachers have more capacity to get to know the children.

I am really happy with my son's induction period and more importantly so is he - it has made the transition into St Bridget's easy, happy and relaxed - he is already feeling happy and confident in his new surroundings with his new teacher and teaching assistant - thank you for making the experience so positive

I think it has been good and he has enjoyed starting school but I am not sure he needed such a staggered settling in period. As he previously went to nursery and preschool I think it was actually harder for him as he didn't understand why he couldn't just stay all day and was actually more of an adjustment than if he had just started full time.

My daughter has settled in much better than expected and I'm very pleased with how it has gone. The week of 2 hours in the afternoon is a bit of a pain, but I understand why it had to be done

He has settled in immediately and is really enjoying school life already. The transition has been smooth and uneventful. Really impressed

Overall very positive. We had mornings first, then afternoons. Really supportive for both children and parents. I have loved hearing how happy he is when he comes out. I wonder if the afternoon sessions could also include lunch? I do however appreciate this needs more adult support to support the morning/afternoon session switchover.

It has been fantastic. She has loved getting to know her teachers and classmates. She is eager to go to school each morning and totally at ease.

We have been really pleased with the school introduction all the way from the parents evening early in summer and 'homework' which kept us all engaged in the preparations for his start at St Bridget's. The chance for parents to go into school and hear from the full range of staff was really reassuring. The half days during the first week was great (even though our son was ill for the first 2 days) as were the lovely touches of the gift bag for parents and giving parents the chance to go into the classroom with the children. He would have liked to have been in school for longer each day during the second week but overall it was a very well-considered build up to full days at school and also helped us as parents to work out our routines at both the start and end of the day.
